

SINCE THE NUCLEAR NON-PROLIFERATION TREATY (NPT) became law in 1970, the world has gathered hopefully at the United Nations every 5 years to review progress toward its historic goal: preventing the spread of nuclear weapons and negotiating their global abolition.

Seven times the review process has failed us:

>Humanity's resources stolen as we struggle against poverty and hunger, injustice and disease and now a looming climate cataclysm;

>Trillions of dollars siphoned off by War and War's ultimate weapon: the nuclear warhead;

>Tantalizing but halting half steps toward reduction of the number of nuclear warheads, which remains a terrifying 23,000, most in the hands of the U.S. and Russia;

>The Nuclear Club expanded to 9 nations, with others threatening to join via NPT Article IV, which promises "peaceful" nuclear power to countries that forgo nuclear weapons, ignoring the fatal link between nuclear energy and nuclear devastation;
